AMANET wishes to recruit on contract terms a Network Manager. S/He will be based at the AMANET Secretariat in Dar-es Salaam, Tanzania.

#### Network Manager

##### *Purpose of the Job*

The Network Manager will assist the AMANET Managing Trustee in carrying out the following:

- planning and implementing programmes, projects and activities of the Secretariat;
- preparing long and short-term plans, including annual plans of action;
- organizing AMANET governance meetings and making necessary follow ups;
- preparing and organizing training workshops, conferences, and similar activities and ensuring preparation of pertinent reports and publications;
- maintaining the necessary communication and coordination within the Network;
- making inputs into financial estimates and reports;
- Preparation of proposals for funding purposes;
- Carrying out any other duties as assigned by the Managing Trustee;

### *Qualifications*

- Preferably a basic degree in biomedical or public health sciences, backed by a postgraduate qualification; experience in biomedical research with good publications will be advantageous;
- Excellent command of oral and written English is essential; a good knowledge of French would be an added advantage;
- Demonstrated experience in institutional leadership is desirable;
- Self motivated, multi-tasked, dynamic personality, with high integrity;
- High competence with computer usage is essential, as are good interpersonal attributes.

### *Emoluments*
